

## Mandatory Instructional Activities Guide

Course Name	<b>Mandatory Activities - These activities require an excused absence from your Student Affairs Dean</b>
FPC1 and FPC2	All course activities including TBLs, small group sessions, CEAC and SIM activities
HAP and HA2	TBLs, practicum experience
ICCC	Small group sessions
CBL1 and CBL2	All weekly case sessions
HSF1, HSF2, HDS	Simulations (SIM)
Frontiers1 and Frontier2	All course Activities

All other TBL, TPS, conferences, laboratories and other live instructional formats are not mandatory and do not require formal excusal by the Student Affairs Deans. However, attendance at these sessions may be counted toward your course process grade.

- If you need to miss a session, you should notify your group members so that they are aware that you will be absent.
- If you expect to miss multiple sessions owing to a longer illness or personal situation (such as quarantine), you need to notify Student Affairs using the DUCOMpass app in order to develop a plan for how you will manage the missed material.
