Your **Drexel University** username consists of your initials and several numbers (e.g., **abc123**). You will use this account to access the **DrexelOne Portal** (http://one.drexel.edu) for **library** and other resources. You can set up your Drexel University account and manage your password at http://accounts.drexel.edu.

Your **DrexelMed** username consists of your first initial plus the first seven letters of your last name (e.g., **jsmith**). Your DrexelMed account **e-mail** address will be your username (e.g., **jsmith@drexelmed.edu**) and you can access your e-mail and manage your password at http://webmail.drexelmed.edu. 


