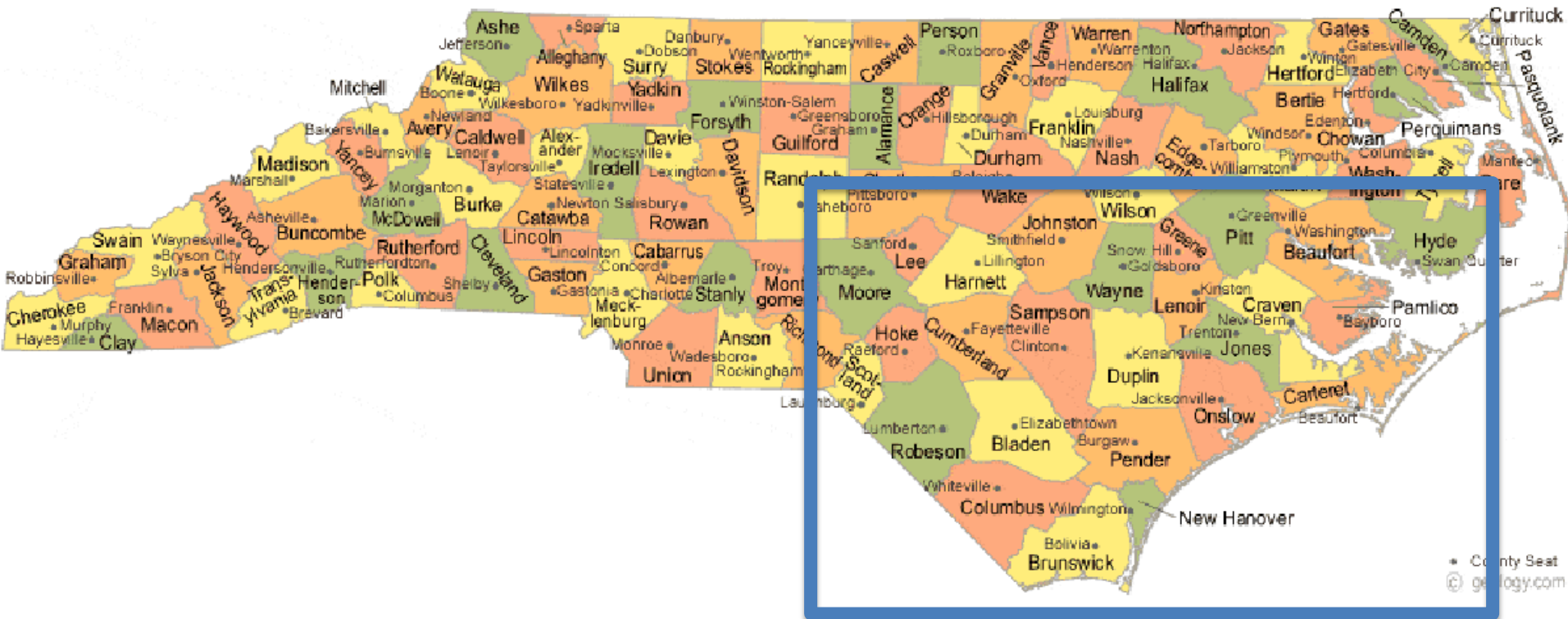


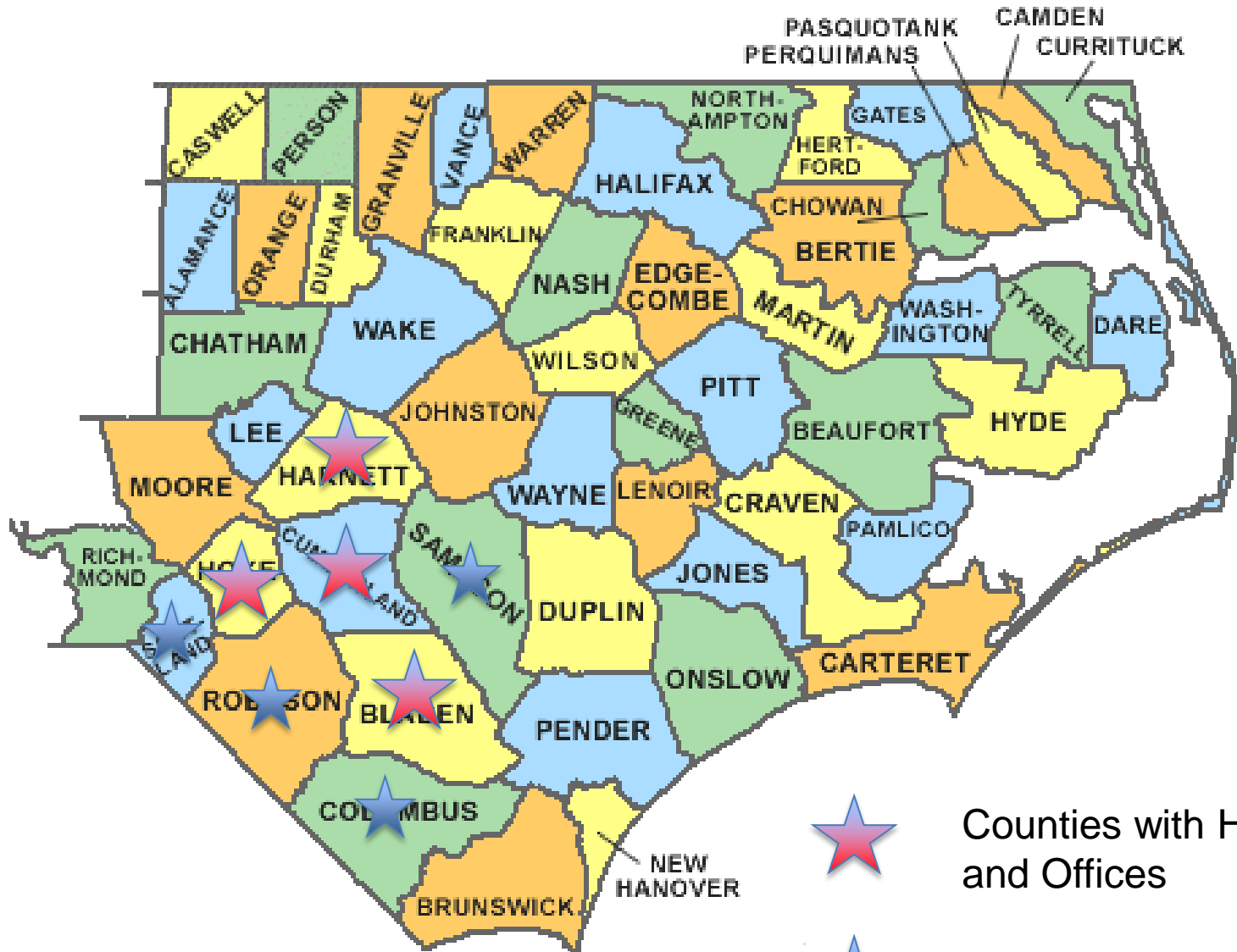

# General Information

- Cape Fear Valley Health System is in Fayetteville, NC and includes hospitals and clinics in surrounding southeastern NC counties
- Hershey S. Bell, MD, MSMedEd, FAAFP serves as Associate Regional Dean for the Campus and Audrea Taylor serves as the coordinator for student rotations
- CORE third year rotations offered at site

# Hospital Data

- Trauma level III
- NICU level III (highest level)
- Health System: 1,000 beds
  - Cape Fear Valley Medical Center has 524 acute care beds and 78 rehabilitation beds
  - A 110-bed addition (with 40 ICU beds) is currently under construction
- Almost 200,000 ER visits in the system
  - CFVMC ED is one of the 12 busiest ED's in the United States
- Number of annual admissions: 45,000
- Number of annual outpatient visits: Approx. 1M (265,000 ED visits)
- Number of deliveries: 5,000
